

FROM THE PRESBYTER'S DESK

Dearly Loved ones in Christ,

Greetings in the name of our precious Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Let us thank and praise God for His providence and guidance in the past month.

Month of July starts with the biblical thought of stewardship. It is a biblical mandate. Bible speaks a lot about this. The Parable of the Talents that we see in Matthew 25:14-30 instructs us the biblical truth,-"We are Stewards not Owners". I am also having the opinion that none of us are owners of anything.
